URGENT ROAD CLOSURE NOTICE

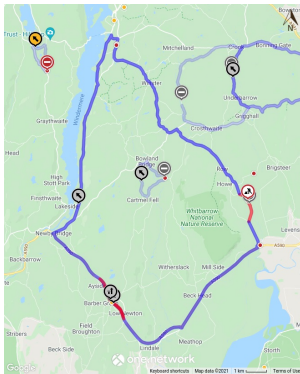
A5074, Lyth Valley

Notice is hereby given that to enable Cumbria County Council to carry out urgent slope stabilisation to retain carriageway edge ("the Works") Cumbria County Council prohibits with immediate effect the passage of vehicular traffic along that section of A5074, Lyth Valley from a point approx. 1420 metres from its junction with the A590, extending in a northern direction for a total distance of approximately 1580 metres, as and when the appropriate traffic signs are displayed.

This notice will be in force for a period not exceeding 5 days from 13th September 2021. It is expected that the Works will take 5 days.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.

A suitable alternative route for vehicles will be signed and available via the unrestricted section of A5074, A590, A592, B5284, A5074.

Nothing in this Notice shall:

1. Apply to emergency service vehicles, or vehicles being used by statutory undertakers in the performance of their duties; and
2. Apply to anything done with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; and
3. Have the effect of preventing at any time access for pedestrians to any premises situated on or adjacent to the roads, or to any other premises accessible for pedestrians from, and only from the roads; and
4. Apply to vehicles being used in connection with the Works.
